

OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE JESUS CHRIST

- Position:** Baptismal Preparation Leader
- Ministry Area:** Operations
- Goal of Position:** To prepare the Baptistry for use in the holy sacrament of Baptism.
- Responsible To:** Deacon of Operations
- Ministry Description:** Preparation:
1. Wipe down baptistry interior to remove dust.
 2. Be sure drain valve is closed.
 3. Turn on valve above hot water tank near kitchen.
 4. Turn valve on at baptistry.
 5. Add bleach to water as it enters - approx. 1 hr to fill.
 6. Do NOT overfill but DO fill above intake outlets.
 7. Set out terry cloth robes and towels per need.
 8. Set out drip pans from behind north choir loft door.
 9. Turn pump on Saturday evening to heat water.
- Post Baptism:
1. Put everything away.
 2. Open drain valve mentioned in Step #2.
 3. Wipe baptistry dry.
 4. Put towels in washing machine and start the wash.
 5. Dry towels and return to storage.

- Preparation Required:** Baptismal preparation leader will be trained in all duties.
- Orientation Provided:** Orientation and safety training provided by the Deacons.
- Qualifications/Special Skills:** No special skills are needed except the willingness to serve in a timely fashion.
