- Position:** Nursery Worker
- Ministry Area:** Outreach
- Goal of Position:** To serve on the nursery team. To see that you provide safe, loving care for the babies.
- Responsible to:** Nursery Director
- Ministry Description:**
- § To make sure you are in the room at your designated arrival time.
 - § To notify your coordinator as soon as possible in case of absence.
 - § To attend periodic nursery meetings.
 - § Immediately check to see that everything is ready: snacks, changing counter, toys, music, blankets, etc.
 - § To keep abreast of current nursery policies and procedures
- Length of Commitment:** From: Through:
- Preparation Required:** The Nursery Director will provide a schedule for when your service is needed in the nursery and a time will be mutually agreed upon to serve, e.g. once a month during the worship hour; or once a month during the disciple hour; or during special events such as fellowship meals or special services; or on Sunday evenings.
- Orientation Provided:** Safety Training and child care orientation provided by the Nursery Director.
- Qualifications/Skills:**
- § Must be born again and committed to maturing in their walk with the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - § Must have a love and concern for children
 - § Must participate in regular ongoing training as the opportunities arise.
 - § Must be 18 years of age. (If younger than 18, the Nursery Assistant Position Description is being developed)
 - § Must be approved by the Elders and Deacons
- Benefits to Volunteer:** You will meet the younger parents of the church and will experience satisfaction in knowing that you are serving the Lord through your assistance in caring for these little ones while their parents are growing in God's word and/or serving in other ministries. You will be one of the first in this child's life to introduce them to Jesus.
